

#### **III. OSH Inspection Systems**

#### 1- Scope of inspection:

The OSH inspectors cover all occupations in enterprises and companies in the private sector under the scope of the Labour Law of Cambodia: Chapter 1: Article 1. So far, informal economy which is not registered by the Ministry is excluded from the inspection. In the process of the Labour Law application, the informal economy will also benefit from the Law within the MoLVT's mandatory labour protection at the national level, for instance, an accidence prevention and insurance.

#### **III. OSH Inspection Systems (Cont)**


#### **Number of inspectors**

- ☐ There are **91** OSH inspectors (**24 based in the Ministry and 67 based in municipality and provinces**) in charge of inspection visits countrywide.
- ☐ In the past, the regular inspection visits have been made only in Phnom Penh City. Since 2010 OSH inspections have been extended nationwide
- ☐ Now Day We combine all in inspector at other department under ministry of Labour and Vocational Training to one group.





#### IV. Issues & challenges

- Improving OSH is only based on labour law, requiring to separated OSH Act and develop more regulations
- Lacking of Human resources such as occupational hygienist, occupational physicians, occupational specialists, toxicologist
- No OSH training and research center (university, institution)
- Less cooperation from employers and employees sites

#### V. Expected outcome

- Strengthen the OSH Management in SMEs and construction sites
- Share a good practices on OSH to SMEs and construction sites
- Extend the ILO training programs such as WISE, WISH, WISCON and WINDs
- Enforce the 2<sup>nd</sup> OSH Master Plan by targeting on SMEs and construction sites
- Establish more OSH awareness and promotion to SMEs and construction sites
