

KOSHA signed arrangement for technical cooperation delivering know-how to establish a professional prevention organization

DLPW(Department of Labor Protection and Welfare) signed an Arrangement for Technical Cooperation with KOSHA to take the Korean organization as a model in the process of founding a professional prevention organization.
